TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

Entries will not be limited except by judging and room constraints. All contestants and judges must take responsibility in getting to draw and rounds on time. The last time we ran a tournament with this schedule, it ran on time through the cooperation of all participants and we are confident it can again.

Registration will occur in the lobby of Crouch Hall. We will email you a parking pass when we send out tournament entries. Please fill out the necessary information and place it on the dashboard of your vehicle. Parking may be a bit crowded on Friday, but there will be plenty of spots available on Saturday and Sunday.

ENTRIES/JUDGES

The entry fee is \$25 per competitor per half of the swing.

PLEASE BRING JUDGES! Each judge covers 4 competitors and all uncovered competitors will be assessed a \$15 judging fee per each half of the swing they compete in. Given the need for as many judges as possible to run an unflighted tournament of this size, we will offer an additional “supercovered” discount. If you bring 1 judge for every 2 competitors, the entry fee for each “supercovered” competitor drops from \$25 to \$15.

ENTRY DEADLINE

Please email your entries to Adam Key (akey1@tnstate.edu) by 5pm on **Tuesday March 18, 2014**. Fees will be assessed at 5pm on **Wednesday, March 19, 2014**. All changes after the deadline will be \$15 (each time). **Drops only at registration.** We will confirm your entries by email. If you do not receive email confirmation within a reasonable time, please contact Adam to make sure we received your entry.

AWARDS

THE BELT BUCKLES ARE BACK! In keeping with the Music City theme, all awards will be music themed. This includes our trademark belt buckle speaker awards.

Awards include:

Trophies for all competitors reaching elimination rounds

1st-5th place belt buckle speaker awards for all divisions

1st-5th place combined speaker awards (competitors from any division with highest combined speaker points for both halves of the swing)

1st-3rd place tournament sweepstakes for each half of the swing

1st-3rd place overall sweepstakes

1st-3rd place Battle of the Bands (squad, with at least 4 competitors in each half, with the highest prelim win percentage over both halves of the swing)

One Man Band (individual competitor of any division with highest win percentage over both halves of the tournament)

Sweepstakes formula

Each prelim win/bye: 5 points (top 4 competitors in each division)

Speaker awards: 1st = 10 points, 2nd = 8 points, 3rd = 6 points, 4th = 4 points, 5th = 2 points

Overall: Country sweeps + Rock & Roll Sweeps + Overall speaker awards
