## **Entry Deadlines, Fees, Judges**

The Debate Team at UT Tyler and Department of Communication at UT Tyler understand that budgets are tight at this time of year, and we appreciate your consideration to compete at the Tournament of Roses. Registration costs will be only \$20 for covered IPDA entries, so PLEASE BRING JUDGES. Each team must provide at least one judge for each FOUR individual IPDA entries. Each team must provide at least one judge for each TWO Team IPDA entries. Eliminated competitors will be used to judge outrounds, and teams are obligated to judge at least one round beyond their elimination, as is typical at IPDA tournaments. Uncovered entries will be subject to an additional \$15 fee. Lunch will be provided on Saturday for all competitors and judges.

Changes may be made before 5:00 PM CT on Tuesday, March 26<sup>th</sup>. Any changes made after this deadline will be subject to a \$10/competitor fee. Invoices will be emailed to each team after the entry deadline. Please make all checks payable to “UT Tyler Communication Department.”

## **Tournament Guidelines and Procedures**

All of the rules and standards governing the International Public Debate Association apply to the Tournament of Roses Invitational at UT Tyler. As such, there shall be no electronic devices (other than timers) or printed evidence used in round. For individual IPDA, speech times are 5-2-6-2-3-5-3. There will be four individual divisions of debate: Novice, Junior Varsity, Varsity, and Professional, which may be collapsed if needed. The IPDA constitution includes requirements for eligibility in each of these divisions.

Team IPDA will be open to all undergraduate competitors, in accordance with the IPDA constitution. Speech times for TIPDA are 4-2-5-2-5-2-4-2-3-4-4-3. The great Keith Milstead has agreed to run tab for the TIPDA portion, so you can be sure of a good tournament.

The tab room will be closed to all competitors during the tournament. If any issues arise, please call Matthew Lucci at (469) 658-2230.

UT Tyler students may compete in order to fill breaks. Every effort will be made not to have UT Tyler competitors judged by UT Tyler judges, but in the event that more judges are needed then clean judges are available we guarantee that the UT Tyler competitors will be judged by non-UT Tyler Team members.

## **Sweepstakes and Awards**

Team, Novice, Junior Varsity, Varsity and Professional will count toward the tournament sweepstakes. Space permitting, there is no limit on entries, but only the top three competitors in each division will count toward the sweepstakes. There will be speaker awards for the top 5 competitors in each division, awards for all advancing competitors in each division, and sweepstakes trophies for the top 3 programs. There will also be an award for the Top Community College. The team with the highest winning percentage (minimum 3 competitors) will also receive the "Patriot Competitive Excellence Award".

Sweepstakes will be determined as follows:

Team IPDA (top 2 teams, 2 points for prelim wins, and 4 points for breaking.)

Individual IPDA (top 3 competitors per division, 1 point for prelim wins, and 2 points for breaking.)

Combined Sweepstakes (combine points for both individual and team divisions)

Speaker awards will also count toward sweepstakes points. Sweepstakes points will be calculated as such: 10 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 8 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 6 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4 for 4<sup>th</sup>, and 2 for 5<sup>th</sup>.

## **Tournament Hotel**
